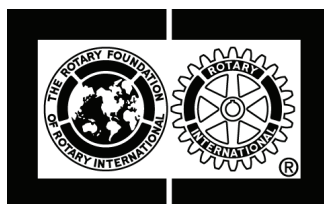

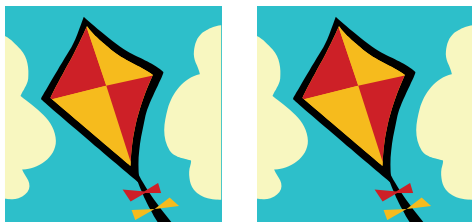

Miles Schwartz

Miles Schwartz, a founding member of the Rotary Club of Des Peres Rotary, passed away Thursday, February 10, from non-Hodgkin's lymphoma. He had suffered for 14 years from complications of cancer. Miles survived with the support of his wife and best friend of 25 years, Suzanne Mitchell Schwartz.

He was born on March 25, 1927, in Detroit, Michigan, the oldest of three children. Miles had a daughter, Katie Fitzpatrick (deceased), a son, Miles Schwartz Jr., and four step-daughters. He had three grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Miles was passionate about Rotary. He was the club's second president and the 1996-97 Rotary district governor. He belonged to the Rotary Club of Kirkwood prior to becoming a charter member of the Des Peres club. He was also a long-time Shriner.

Tim is also one of the producers of the Broadway play *High*, opening April 19 on Broadway. It came to St. Louis as one of the three cities where it was developed – and extensive work was done on it here while at the Repertory Theatre of St. Louis.

Playbill describes the story as an exploration of the “universal themes of truth, forgiveness, redemption and human fallibility. When Sister Jami-son Connelly (Kathleen Turner) agrees to sponsor a 19-year-old drug user (Evan Jonigkeit) in an effort to help him combat his addiction, her own faith is ultimately tested. Struggling between the knowledge she possesses as a rehabilitation counselor and a woman of religious conviction, she begins to question her belief in miracles and whether people can find the courage to change.” Tim says he is one of the producers because “I like the piece and want to bring it to a broader public.”
