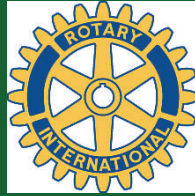
Nick's News

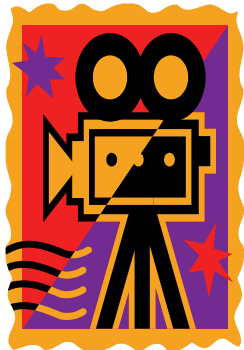

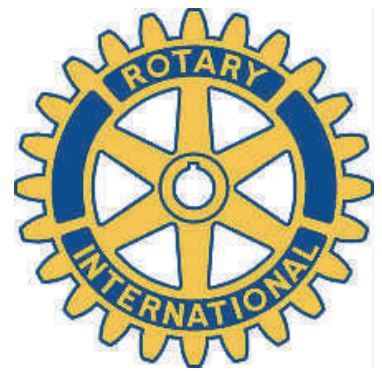
